## Instructions to New Range at Andersons Rd Helidon.

**Coming from Brisbane:** Take the Warrego Highway west and turn left off the highway, use underpass into the town of Helidon on the northern side of the highway. Proceed north along Lawler St, turn right into Station St.

**Coming from Toowoomba:** Take the Warrego Highway east and turn left off the highway into the town of Helidon on the northern side of the highway into Turner St. Cross railway line at Station St.

**Both** - Proceed NE along Station St to stop sign at T Junction. Turn left into Conners Rd, Turn right into Wrights Rd, Wrights Rd becomes Andersons Rd (keep left), proceed along Anderson Rd for approx 2km on dirt. Turn right into gateway marked "Toowoomba Pistol Club". Proceed up bitumen road with care.

## **ISSF 50M RUNNING BOAR TARGET 22LR.**

Because our club does not yet have a 90m Metallic Silhouette range constructed, we will introduce the exciting ISSF Running Boar Target 50m match for 2011. As far as we know this is the only event of this type in Queensland and perhaps Australia.

Running target is an exciting snap shooting match that combines the accuracy of rifle with the instinctive pointing of shotgun. The match is shot with any bolt action 22LR with any sights from a standing position. We have club rifles available for you to hire for \$3. The target is a paper double headed boar with a 10 ring scoring target located at the boars front shoulder area at each end of the target. The bulls-eye is located 500mm from the boar's nose on the boar's shoulder.

The paper boar target runs in both directions across a 10m gap with a 5 second exposure and the shooter shoots 1 scoring shot for each pass and starts with the rifle stock on the hip and barrel facing upwards. The shooter gets a chance to dry fire a practice match from a neighboring bay prior to moving to the firing bay. The shooter gets 4 sighting shots (2 in each direction) and normally 40 scoring shots. Depending on the timing we may run separate 20/20 shot strings and may limit number of entries if necessary because we have a single firing point. So all you silhouette shooters and armchair hunters, come and have a go at something you haven't tried before and see who will be crowned the 2011 Running Target champion!
